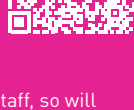

STUDENT SERVICES: STUDENT ADVICE

Student Advice are here to support you with all aspects of life at Leeds Beckett. Whatever the question, they'll either have the answer, or they'll help put you in touch with someone who does. The team are based in the Student Services Centres in the Leslie Silver Building (City Campus) and Priestley Building (Headingley Campus).

COURSE ADMINISTRATOR

Your Course Admin are here to ensure that you have the smoothest possible student experience whilst studying with us. If you have a question about your course or if you experience any problems, they are a great first person to ask.



Your Course Admin work closely with academic staff, so will be able to help with a range of academic queries. They can make referrals to teaching staff or to specialist professional services if needed. You can find out your Course Admin from your Course Handbook.

ACADEMIC ADVISER

Speak to your Academic Adviser about any aspects of your course; if you're struggling to meet a deadline, or have personal issues impacting on your studies and need academic advice and support on mitigation. They can help with signposting and referrals to support services across the University too. You can find out your Academic Adviser at your Course Induction or from your Course Administrator.



STUDENT SERVICES: STUDENT WELLBEING

We offer resources and information about events and services that can help you look after your mental health and wellbeing online.

Student Wellbeing also provide confidential short-term counselling and mental health support. You can register online to self-book your first appointment.

Our School Based Wellbeing Practitioners are working directly with your academic schools, offering guidance and support to enhance positive wellbeing and healthy behaviours.

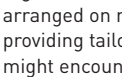


INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS - STUDENT IMMIGRATION ADVICE AND COMPLIANCE
