If you do not meet these requirements then your visa application will be refused. Do not apply for your visa if you cannot meet these requirements.

When are financial documents not required? If you are a **national** of an exempt country listed in the [UKVI Immigration Rules](#), you should still obtain the evidence of your money, but you do not need to include it with your CAS request form or your initial Student visa application.

Nationals from countries that are not exempt, US loan recipients and sponsored students must include financial evidence with your CAS request and in your Student visa application. See below for details of what is required.

If you are a self-funded applicant, please provide:

- A bank statement in your name **or** your parents(s)/legal guardian(s)*

*If you are using your parents(s)/legal guardian(s) account then you must also provide the following:

- Your birth certificate.
- A permission letter from your parent(s) / legal guardian(s) which must confirm the relationship between you and your parent(s) / legal guardian(s) **and** that they have given their consent to you using the funds to study in the UK.

If you are a sponsored applicant, please provide:

- A copy of your official sponsor letter/financial guarantee.

If you are a US loan applicant, please provide:

- A copy of your notification of student loan letter.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **Do I have to send Leeds Beckett University copies of my financial documents?**

If you are a **national** of an exempt country listed in the [UKVI Immigration Rules](#) you should obtain the evidence of your money, but you **do not** need to include it with your CAS request to us or your initial Student visa application. **Nationals from countries that are not exempt, US loan recipients, and sponsored students must** include financial evidence with the CAS request and Student visa application. See [Section 6](#) for more information.

- **Do I need to have a Naric Statement of Comparability?**

You only need to have this document if:

- 1) You have completed a degree from a majority-English Speaking country (as per [UKVI Student Visa Policy Guidance](#) - **not** including the UK).
- 2) You are **not** a national from one of these countries.
- 3) You are using this degree as evidence of meeting the UKVI Student visa English Language requirement.

We need to see a copy of this document before issuing CAS. You will also need to submit this document during your Student visa application. If you are unsure of whether you need to have this document, please contact us as soon as possible.

- **How long will it take to receive my CAS number?**

We aim to issue CAS numbers as soon as we can. In order for us to do this, we need your tuition fees to have cleared (or submission of a sponsor letter / loan documents) and all other correct documents submitted to us (financial evidence, passport, evidence of previous visas and/or visa refusals).

- **How will my CAS number be sent?**

Your CAS number will be sent via email to your personal email address. Please ensure you have provided the University with your correct email address.

- **I have made an extra payment towards tuition fees, can my CAS be updated?**

If you have made extra tuition fee payments, [email the CAS Team](#) a copy of your receipt as soon as possible. The CAS Team can update your CAS with the new amount you have paid, but the money will need to be showing in University's account systems before the CAS can be updated. Please remember that some payment methods take longer than others.

- **I have paid an accommodation deposit; will this be on my CAS?**

Only deposits for Leeds Beckett University accommodation will be noted on your CAS. Any deposits for private accommodation will not be noted on your CAS. Please provide a copy of your accommodation deposit receipt along with other CAS documents when requesting a CAS number.

- **There are incorrect details on my CAS, what should I do?**

If there are incorrect details on your CAS, [email the CAS Team](#) immediately. In most cases we will not need to re-issue a CAS because we can instead add a "sponsor note". These sponsor notes are fully visible to the UKVI and your CAS number will remain unchanged.

- **How much money do I need to have for my visa application?**

- **I am applying for my visa in the UK, is there any support available to me?**

Leeds Beckett University have a [Student Immigration Advice and Compliance team](#) who can help you with your visa application in you are applying from within the UK.



- **What happens if my Student visa application is refused?**

If your first visa application is refused, you must [inform the CAS Team immediately](#) and send us a copy of your visa refusal letter.

- **I have been issued a CAS but I will not be joining Leeds Beckett University, what should I do?**

If you have been issued a CAS but are no longer joining Leeds Beckett University, you must [inform the CAS Team](#) as soon as possible and confirm if you have submitted a visa application so that we can advise you further.

- **I cannot make it to the University before the latest enrollment date on my CAS – what should I do?**

Your CAS states the latest date you can arrive in the UK and enrol on your course. If you cannot make this date, you must [email the CAS Team](#) as soon as possible so that we can advise you further. We do not advise traveling to the UK without a valid visa and a letter from the University confirming approval for you to arrive late.
