Safeguarding Adults at Risk

Developed in partnership with Toolwire, this tool is designed for pre-qualifying and newly qualified social work students in their Assessed and Supported Year in Practice. In the tool, the learner plays the part of a newly qualified Social Worker working with an adult with dementia, following the process of an adult safeguarding case under the supervision of their line manager. Learners interact with real life characters as they undertake observations and assessments and apply legal and policy frameworks. The learner works in collaboration with service users and carers and with other members of the multidisciplinary team in adult safeguarding practice.

Experiential learning enables the learner to practice skills and decision making in complex cases and to integrate theories and practice. The tool replicates practice and so provides an immersive learning experience.

The learner will experience an authentic and engaging learning environment that combines sound pedagogical principles with innovative technologies. This important tool enhances the use of virtual and physical learning spaces, and early impact analysis suggests it improves student learning.
