What happened, What changed and What is new – Mark Hillier, Course Director for Practice, Leeds Beckett University.</p> <p>Natural break</p> <p>Culturally competent placement provision</p> <p>We support a wide variety of students on placement, and each student arrives with unique learning needs depending on their previous experience and skill development. However, a more nuanced support of a student takes account of their cultural, educational and social history. This lecture will asks participants to reflect on their own awareness as Practice Assessors of power dynamics within the student relationship and develop their inclusive practice to engage students. Paula Beesley is a senior lecturer in social work at Leeds Beckett University. As a qualified social worker and qualified Practice Educator, she is currently undertaking a PhD researching collaborative, experiential social work student supervision in placements.
